



SOLANA BEACH SCHOOL DISTRICT 2022-2023 PARENT/GUARDIAN HEALTH AND SAFETY AGREEMENT

This Parent/Guardian Health and Safety Agreement is based on the requirements from the California Department of Public Health. In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19, the District will also review these rules and protocols with students throughout the school year. I have read, understand, and agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. Daily Student Symptom and Exposure Protocol. Parent/Guardian understands and agrees that all families complete the Daily Student Symptom and Exposure Protocol **prior** to arrival at school each day:

- a. If parent/guardian answers **YES** to either question on the protocol, they **MUST** keep their child(ren) home, even if symptoms are mild.
- b. Parent/guardian **MUST** contact their school office to report the absence. The child(ren) may not return to school until:
 - Student receives a negative test result from a Lab-processed PCR or NAAT Test
OR
 - Student receives a negative test results from two antigen tests taken at least 12 hours apart
 - Child(ren) has not had a fever for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications and symptoms have improved
OR
 - Ten days have passed from the onset date of the first symptom

2. Exhibiting Symptoms at School. If a student meets the criteria for COVID-19 signs and symptoms, the student will be sent home. District Nurse and/or health office personnel will communicate COVID-19 test options, if requested.

- If a positive test result is obtained, parent/guardian will be notified of the protocol, testing options and the student will need to isolate at home per San Diego County Health & Human Services Agency (HHSA) guidelines.

3. Disclosure to Help Prevent Community Spread of COVID-19. Parent/Guardian understands and agrees that if their child(ren) tests positive for COVID-19 or if the District otherwise reasonably suspects their child(ren) is infected with COVID-19, the District is required to notify the San Diego HHSA. Additionally:

In order to conduct contact tracing, the District may be required to contact the child(ren)'s close contacts who may have been exposed to the virus. To protect student privacy, the District will only inform close contacts that they may have been exposed to someone with the infection. The District will not disclose the identity of the child(ren) who may have exposed them.

To help protect against community spread, the District will be performing its own contact tracing. Parent/Guardian agrees for the District to ask their child(ren) and Parent/Guardian questions

about everyone within the school community who a child(ren) may have had close contact with during the timeframe they may have been infectious.

4. **Testing.** For many reasons, students are being tested for COVID-19 whether exhibiting symptoms or not. If a student has tested with a lab-processed PCR or NAAT to detect the virus that causes COVID-19, they must remain at home and not report to school until a negative test result is issued. If the test result is positive, this information must be reported to your school site.

5. **Nondiscrimination.** The District prohibits discrimination against any student who has been diagnosed with COVID-19, whose family member has been diagnosed with COVID-19, or who is perceived to be a COVID-19 risk. If you feel your child(ren) is being discriminated against as a result of COVID-19, please notify the District immediately.

6. **Responsibility to Quarantine.** Parent/Guardian understands that the District may direct their child(ren) to quarantine either because their child(ren) is suspected of having COVID-19 or because their child(ren) has been in direct close contact with someone suspected of having COVID-19. If directed to quarantine, Parent/Guardian understands and agrees to the following:

- a. Students who are required to quarantine, but feel well enough to participate in their learning, are expected to continue to participate with a continuity of learning plan.

7. **Visitors/Volunteers** Partnering with our families is an integral part of the success of our students. SBSB utilizes a volunteer/visitor management system. This visitor/volunteer management system has new and existing provisions for visitors and volunteers. 8. **Recommended At-Home Cleaning Procedures.** In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19, the District encourages Parent/Guardian to, on a daily basis, clean/thoroughly wash their child(ren)'s commonly touched items such as, backpacks, lunch boxes, water bottles, and clothes.

9. **Vaccinations.** It is recommended that students be immunized for influenza unless contraindicated by personal medical conditions. It is recommended that students who are ages 5-12 receive the COVID-19 vaccination.

- To protect the school community
- Reduce demands on healthcare facilities
- Influenza vaccines decrease illnesses that cannot be readily distinguished from COVID-19 and would, therefore, trigger extensive measures from the school and Public Health authorities
