<b>R</b> esponsible and Safe Citizens	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Stop, think, and make good choices.</li><li>• Treat the lunch area as if it were your home.</li><li>• Raise your hand if you need anything, including to use the restroom.</li><li>• Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.</li><li>• If you see trash, please</li></ul>
<b>I</b> nnovative	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Help others learn the rules of a game or lunch expectations.</li><li>• Participate in games,</li></ul>
<b>D</b> emonstrate Respect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use appropriate voice level.</li><li>• Follow directions from school adults the first time.</li><li>• Do not “cut” others or save places in line.</li></ul>
<b>E</b> ncourage and Include Others	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Find someone new to sit with or who may need a friend</li><li>• Synergize.</li><li>• Sharpen the Saw.</li></ul>



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## Assembly Expectations

<b>P</b> ersonal Best	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Participate Appropriately.</li><li>• Use good manners.</li></ul>
<b>R</b> esponsible and Safe	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Enter and exit quietly and calmly.</li><li>• Sit in assigned area with your class.</li><li>• Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.</li></ul>
<b>I</b> nnovative Learners	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Stay focused on the presentation.</li><li>• Be an active listener and make eye contact with performers/presenters.</li><li>• Remember your questions in</li></ul>
<b>D</b> emonstrate Respect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Applaud when appropriate and always be courteous (applause is the only appropriate response. It is inappropriate to “boo,” whistle, blurt out, etc.)</li><li>• Accept, appreciate, and respect everyone.</li><li>• Remain quiet during the</li></ul>
<b>E</b> ncourage and Include Others	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Applaud appropriately for all presenters or performers.</li></ul>

<b>D</b> emonstrate Respect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Respect the privacy and personal space of others.</li><li>• Re-enter the classroom quietly and</li></ul>
<b>E</b> ncourage and Include Others	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Treat the school restrooms as if they were in your home and encourage others to do the same.</li></ul>

<b>D</b> emonstrate Respect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Respect the privacy and personal space of others.</li><li>• Seek first to understand then to be understood.</li><li>• Use the Walk, Talk, or Rock-it Strategy to solve disagreements.</li><li>• Respect property.</li><li>• Seek an adult if you have a</li></ul>
<b>E</b> ncourage and Include Others	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be cooperative, kind, and inclusive to everyone.</li><li>• All students can participate in all games.</li><li>• See win-win when playing with others.</li></ul>
