Purpose: Provide Information COVID-19 Testing, Vaccination Clinics, and COVID-19 Vaccine Record

OUTCOMES:

Provide Governing Board with recommendations regarding:

- 1. A status update regarding CDPH health and safety recommendations
- 2. Class size flexibility for the 2021-22 school year
- 3. Asymptomatic surveillance testing and symptomatic/response testing for students and staff for the 2021-22 school year.
- 4. SBSD hosted vaccination clinics for students, staff, and families during the 2021-22 school year.
- 5. SBSD staff and family voluntary enrollment in CA Digital COVID-19 Vaccine Record.

Health Guidance Agencies



2021-22 Proposed Health and Safety Measures

(Utilize CDPH Framework for Reopening Schools)*

- 1. Facial covering required for all staff and all students indoors; facial coverings are optional outside
- 2. Healthy hygiene breaks
- 3. Maintain existing increased cleaning and disinfecting
- 4. Sufficient ventilation
 - Maintain increased outdoor air into classrooms
 - b. MERV 13 HVAC filters
- 5. Continue outdoor learning activities
- 6. **Passive** daily staff and student symptom and exposure checks
- 7. Asymptomatic, symptomatic and response COVID-19 testing
- 8. Quarantine timelines
- 9. Internal (district nurses) and external (county health department) contact tracing

Other 2021-22 Proposed SBSD Health & Safety Measures

- 1. Stable groupings will be expanded
 - Continues to support contact tracing
- 2. All employees offered access to N95 masks and eye protection
- 3. Voluntary vaccinations
 - Students when available (emergency use approval not expected until the end of 2021 at the earliest per SDCOE)

Proposed Onsite Staffing & Class Configurations

Continue to prioritize students and staff with health and safety mitigation measures by:

- For **2021-22 ONLY**, as a pandemic safety measure, onsite class sizes are, whenever possible, configured at:
 - K-3 20:1
 - **4-6** 25:1
- Principal determines class size based on*:
 - 1) maximizing health and safety,
 - 2) minimizing combination classes, and
 - 3) preventing families from having to enroll children into multiple schools
- Return to collective bargaining agreement class sizes in 2022-23
 - K-3 24:1
 - **4-6** 28:1

Current Considerations for Testing

- 1. Current case rate for San Diego County 7.6 per 100,000 (7-21-21)
- 2. Current case rate for Solana Beach 6.1 per 100,000 (7-21-21)
- 3. Zero in-school transmissions of the virus during 2020-21 due to implementing multiple mitigation measures

2021-22 COVID-19 Testing Recommendation

1. Enroll in California K-12 Testing Program

- Abbott Binax NOW Rapid Antigen Test (Surveillance Testing)
- Cue Point-of-Care Molecular Test (Symptomatic and Response Testing)
- 2. Eight-week asymptomatic surveillance testing cadence (Aug 16 Oct 8)
 - Voluntary for Staff and Students
- 3. Symptomatic Testing and Response Testing (August 2021 June 2022)
 - Symptomatic Testing in Health Offices at School Sites as needed
 - Pursuing contract w/ UC San Diego Health for Staff as needed
- 4. Status Update at October 14 Governing Board Meeting

45-minute weekly clinics at each school site

Clinic Participants: District Nurse, Health Clerk/LVN, and one to two additional classified employees

Vaccination Clinic(s) Update

 District will submit a request to host vaccination clinics on SBSD facilities when majority of SBSD students become eligible (under age 12).

CA Digital COVID-19 Vaccine Record

- CA Digital Vaccine Record enables registrants to manage their personal vaccination record (voluntary enrollment)
- The District will share registration information with staff and families

Summary of Staff Recommendations

- 1. Provide school sites class size flexibility.
- Administer voluntary asymptomatic surveillance testing for both staff and students for an 8-week testing cycle with status update at the October 14, 2021 Board meeting.
- 3. Administer voluntary symptomatic/response testing for students and staff for the entire 2021-22 school year.
- 4. Host SBSD vaccination clinics for students, staff, and families during the 2021-22 school year when a vaccine is available to our eligible student population.
- 5. Provide SBSD staff and families information to voluntarily enroll in the California Digital COVID-19 Vaccine Record.
