Meals:

SBSD families with financial considerations and who are participants in our Free and Reduced Priced Meal Lunch Program (FRPM), Child Nutrition Services have taken measures to ensure that there will be no interruption in daily service with providing meals to these students.

Beginning Monday, March 16, 2020, meals are being served at three sites Monday through Friday from 11:30am – 12:30pm, each week that we are closed (excluding the week of Spring Break April 6-10), The three distribution sites are Skyline, Solana Ranch, and Solana Highlands. Distribution will be at the front of the Schools. These sites will offer a drive through/walk up "Grab & Go" service whereas students, when accompanied by a parent or guardian, will be able to receive a bagged lunch including a daily entrée, vegetables, fruit, milk, and juice. Locations are subject to change. Families in the meal program will be notified of any such changes.
