December 14th, 6:00-8:00, Skyline's Theater



MEMORIZE A FALL POEM (Dec. 3-Dec. 7)

Your child will receive a packet of fall poems from his/her teacher prior to the topic sharing week. Your child is to choose a poem from the collection to memorize and share with the class. In addition to memorizing the poem, your child needs to practice "performing" the poem by reciting the poem fluently and with expression. Props are a welcome addition for this poem sharing.

CELEBRATION ARTIFACTS (Dec. 17 -21)

We will be studying how communities around the world hold celebrations. Your child will have an opportunity to share the special traditions you observe in your house during the winter holidays. Your child is to select an artifact used in your celebration (ornament, cookie cutter, dreidel) and place it in a paper bag.
