Enrollment Procedures

The Solana Beach School Board has approved the Global Education Program as an alternative education option within the framework of the public-school system. This program is open to all parents legally residing within the Solana Beach School District. The decision to participate is made by the individual families in this choice program. The Program is governed by the Solana Beach School Board, and both the School Board Policy (6181) and Administrative Regulations may be viewed by request in the school site offices or at the school district office.

1. The Global Education staff suggests that parents visit several classrooms within the program. Since this is intended as a program in which students will remain throughout their elementary school experience, parents are encouraged to view and observe all classrooms.
2. Fill out the Global Education Program registration form that includes a selection of either a SSL or monolingual strand choice. This form may be obtained from the Skyline school office or from the Global Education staff.
3. When the Global Education Program student requests for admission exceed program capacity applications, the first students to be selected are students

with current siblings already in the program, and then the remaining student admission by lottery. Those students not selected will remain on a waiting list.

Observation Guidelines

*We appreciate your interest in the Global Education program

*After you've checked in with the office, as you enter the classrooms, find a comfortable place to observe. You are welcome to walk around the room during your observation or find an available seat in the back of the room

*Please feel free to linger and get a true feeling for the classroom (longer than 2 seconds!) A recommendation is at least 5 minutes

*Please be respectful of the fact that instruction is taking place. The teacher will be unable to greet you or have a conversation with you. The same goes for parents who are working with children, please allow them to fulfill their volunteering responsibilities.
