DESIGN A SOLANA BEACH HOUSE OF THE FUTURE (May 16- May 24)

As we bring our study of community to an end, we look to the future and speculate how our community will change and still meet the needs of the people who live here. The children in Global Ed. will be involved in creating a large-scale model of Solana Beach in the future on May 20th. Your child will need to build a house to include as part of our model city. Your child will need to think about what might change in the future that would affect home construction. Will the sea level rise in Solana Beach? Will there be a greater use of solar power? Would people be more actively involved in growing their own vegetables and fruit? Discuss these ideas prior to gathering recyclable materials to build the model home. Specific size requirements for the model home will be sent home prior to this sharing. Lot size is limited in our model city (see, some things never change in Solana Beach!)

FAVORITE ACTIVITY OF THE YEAR (May 30-June 3)

We managed to fit a wealth of learning and experiences into 180 days this school year! Your child is to think back over this year and select one favorite event or activity. Paper will be sent home for your child to write about his/her favorite activity.
