Carmel Creek School hosts Young Scientists Club (YSC) before school, allowing students to learn about and participate in community-supported STREAM workshops.

Carmel Creek School Cougars roar with excitement! - Arriving before the first school bell, Carmel Creek students readily engage in conversations and experiments focused on STREAM learning, (Science, Technology, Research, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics). In Solana Beach School District (SBSD) STREAM labs, educators emphasize these subjects through inquiry-based, hands-on curriculum, driven

by the goal of more closely aligning instruction to what students will experience in college and the workplace. Carmel Creek School STREAM leader, Tiffany Farnsworth, with the support of her colleagues, leads students through cross-disciplinary programs, and has collaborated with school site staff, volunteers, and the neighboring community to ensure new and engaging lessons are being taught.

During the YSC meeting on January 26, Carmel Creek School students learned about the different functions of air pressure through the instruction of Dr. Elena Koslover, former physics professor at UCSD, UCSD student volunteers Mark Paddoch, Yejin Na, Sanchi Saitia, Sincheng Huang, and



volunteer Carmel Creek School community members. Dr. Koslover, alongside our devoted educators and volunteers, has been hosting the club for five years, even providing lessons remotely during COVID-19. Carmel Creek School students explored the functions of air pressure in space through hands-on experimentation, collaboration, and discussions with each other, joyously reacting to the fungibility of the materials with which they experimented.
