



## It's Official! SBSD Board of Education President Julie Union and Appointee Dana King Elected to New Terms

Mrs. Union, whose children attended SBSD schools, is dedicated to building community. "It is an honor to be elected by our community after having been appointed earlier this year to serve on the Solana Beach School District Board of Education," said Mr. King. "Despite the challenges

The strength and determination in our learning community is so inspiring; together, we'll provide our students, families and employees with the resources and support they need to maintain and enhance high-quality learning and mental well-being in both onsite or online learning."
