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'Imagining Our Vivid Vision' Committee to Recommend New Mission and Vision Statements, While Refining the District's Student Promotion Profile

The *Imagining Our Vivid Vision* committee, made up of individuals from throughout SBSD's schools and communities, gathered virtually in late November to discuss and vote on its slate of

mission and vision statements. The final statements will be presented for Board approval in early 2021. "Our aim is to create a mission statement that is intentional, reflects our district's core values, and one that everyone can restate and understand," said Superintendent Jodee Brentlinger. "The impetus behind this and a new



vision statement, particularly in light of the immense changes in education today, is to provide a clear, enduring guide that leads us into an unknown future with wisdom and imagination.
