How's an extra \$200 million San Diego? - We have Solana Beach School District alumni, Callum, Chloe, Jackson, Miles, Sophia, and Trey, to thank, whose invention could render significant energy savings for San Diego County. Formerly Solana Highlands and Solana Pacific students, the Brainy Builders team is composed of 8th graders, who compete, mentor, and work with younger robotics teams, including students from both Carmel Creek and Solana Ranch schools. On Saturday December 3, team Brainy Builders competed in the High Tech High So Cal FLL Super Powered Regional Championship tournament, recording the highest robot game score in Southern California and placing second overall



including robot game, robot design, innovation project, and core values.

The FLL robotics annual challenge involves designing, building, and programming robots to complete challenges, researching and working on a solution to a problem based on the year's theme, and then present this all clearly at competition, all whilst demonstrating core values and gracious professionalism. The Brainy Builders is a First Lego League team, which also features Team **Imagination** from Carmel

Creek school, Electric Doritos and Electric Energy Builders from Solana Highlands School, BerryBotics from Solana Pacific School, and Dynamic Droids from Solana Ranch School. Brainy Builders' innovation project, the *Smartlet*, is a new fully DC outlet system (electrical connector for supplying direct current)
